


Smart pet ID tag


1. Pull out the battery insulator, and then the device will be turned on

immediately.





- 2. Download and install the **Jimi Life** App from the App Store (iOS devices) or Google Play (Android devices).


- 1. Open the "Jimi Life" App, select the corresponding product and scan the QR code on the back of the Tracker.
- 2. Change the device name: Tap Settings-Device-select your device to edit the device name, or you can choose an emoticon for your device.



- 1. The unit uses a CR2032 battery.
- 2. Please use a pry bar or other tools to separate the upper and lower cover through the grooves on the top.
- 3. Choose the battery purchased from a regular supplier and insert it in the direction indicated by the arrow on the mainboard.







Note: Please do not immerse the battery in water or put it into fire, please do not destroy or force open the battery, the battery is disposable and does not support charging. To protect the environment, please recycle the used battery.

- 3. Because the device adopts a crowdsourcing network, there may be a delay in positionings, such as the management platform and APP no you can wait half an hour to refresh the location information. And try to open the device in the place where there are more cell phones.
- 4. Please do not disassemble the device, improper handling by non-professionals may cause damage to the device.

₩FAQ

1. How do you confirm that the device has been turned?

The product beeps when the plastic piece is removed.

2. How do you turn off the device?

The device has low power consumption and can not be shut down; If you need to shut down the device, you need to pull out the battery.
